

Transfer Articulation Encoding Workshop

Who Should Take This Course: This course is for the new transfer evaluator, the experienced evaluator who is new to u.achieve/DARwin, or anyone who wants to learn more about the software's transfer articulation (TA) functionality. This workshop is appropriate for ANY version of u.achieve or DARwin

Course Content: The redLantern Transfer Articulation Workshop is a multi-media, blended training approach that combines self-paced, individual work with lab-style learning, guided hands-on practice, and trainers with real-world transfer experience. The workshop begins with our pre-workshop TA web course to get you familiar with the basics. You then join us and up to 20 of your peers at the redLantern training facility for 3.5 days of intensive trainer-led lecture and exercises on TA concepts and encoding in the u.achieve/DARwin client.
